1	True or false; From the 1920's to the 1940's, pink was the colour assigned to boys, and blue to girls	<b>True</b> - The practise of assigning colours to genders began in the 1920's / Pink was considered appropriate for boys because it was the more masculine and decided colour, whereas blue was considered more delicate & dainty
2	What pink piggy pals first hit British TV screens in 1957?	<b>Pinky &amp; Perky</b> - Created by Czechoslovakian immigrants Jan and Vlasta Dalibor / The puppets spoke and sang in high-pitched voices created by re-playing original voice recordings at a higher speed, they performed cover versions of popular songs, and performed comedy sketches often with a human foil (similar to Basil Brush) / Returned with more characters in Nov 2008
3	What type of pink car was cosmetic queen, Mary Kay, the first to buy in 1968?	<b>A pink Cadillac</b> - As a very successful rolling advertisement, it became the trademark of her cosmetics company / She had ordered the colour to match the 'Mountain Laurel' pink blush inside her compact
4	In what film does actor Steve Buscemi say, "Why am I Mr. Pink"?	<b>Reservoir Dogs</b> - The 1992 debut film of writer & director Quentin Tarantino
5	What is the derogatory term used to describe a person with mild communist or socialist beliefs?	<b>A pinko</b> - The term has its origins in the notion that pink is a watered down version of red, the colour associated with communism / Used in popular culture quite a bit, Pinko Mag for instance, is an online magazine, the Journal of Conscientious Hedonism
6	What song by The Psychedelic Furs was the inspiration for a film of the same name?	<b>Pretty In Pink</b> - The 1986 'Brat Pack' movie is about teenage love & social cliques in 1980s American high schools / The 1986 song reached No 18 in the UK charts
7	What serious newspaper has been printed in pink since 1893?	<b>The Financial Times</b> - Salmon pink was chosen to distinguish the paper from its competitors
8	Who portrayed the dumb but loveable Vernon Pinkley in 'The Dirty Dozen'?	<b>Donald Sutherland</b> - The 1967 WWII film where 12 American soldiers convicted of capital offences are sent on a mission to infiltrate a château in Brittany used as a retreat for senior Wehrmacht officers
9	What line is assigned the colour pink on the tube map of London Underground?	<b>Hammersmith &amp; City</b> - Runs from Hammersmith in West London to Barking in East London / Formerly part of the Metropolitan Line, part of it is the oldest underground railway in the world, as it includes the first part of the London Underground, the section between Paddington & Farringdon, which opened in 1863
10	Sporting an impressive pair of eyelashes, which Rainbow character was Pink?	<b>George</b> - In the 1980's children's TV Show, George was a shy, pink, slightly camp hippo
